Moved to tears while doing yoga at home—that was me a few months ago, when all of the sudden the words to a song playing in the background of a yoga video interrupted my practice. "Leave what's heavy behind" were words in the refrain. And then these other words of the song spoke to me too: "If you're feeling lost and lonely go and figure out why" and "don't we all just want to be together" and "are you tired, are you weary of the hidden hate you've been holding?" … *leave what's heavy behind*.

I had not heard of the group Birdtalker before, but I invite you to listen to this song of theirs, "Heavy". For after naming grief and loneliness and sadness, there's this: "the only way to lose that fearful feeling- replace it with love that's healing."

Let's leave what's heavy behind, for we can only carry so much at one time. Let us entrust our worries and cares, sorrows and joys to God, so that we can embrace and embody the healing love of Jesus.

Please join in faithful prayer and participation as we enter into the new year ahead. Let us pray for God to lead us and guide us. Let's participate in worshipping God, and serving, caring, and loving one another and the world around us. Loving God, lead us into this new year.
