
Even though there are hints and signs of Christmas preparations in sight before Halloween, Reformation, and All Saints draw near as we move from October to November, I know we are still a ways away from Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve. Breathe in, breathe out, we can stay present in this moment without hurrying forward too quickly. Soon enough we will gather to give thanks to God and by the end of November we'll begin lighting a candle on the Advent wreath.

While the new calendar year is still not yet here, our church year is about to turn. For the past few years we have noted this change in the liturgical year as we notice and name the seasons, the colors of the day, and on November 23, we will gather in worship at the end of one year as we enter into the next.

I invite you to worship that Sunday, and to gather afterward and begin a conversation for the year ahead. In November, there is a new book being released, written by Diana Butler Bass, <u>A Beautiful Year</u>, which features a weekly meditation on faith, wisdom, and perseverance.

You are invited to mark the year ahead alongside this devotional and consider gathering throughout the year to share reflections on the readings, to be in conversation with others, and share prayer together.
