

Transfiguration Art for Worship

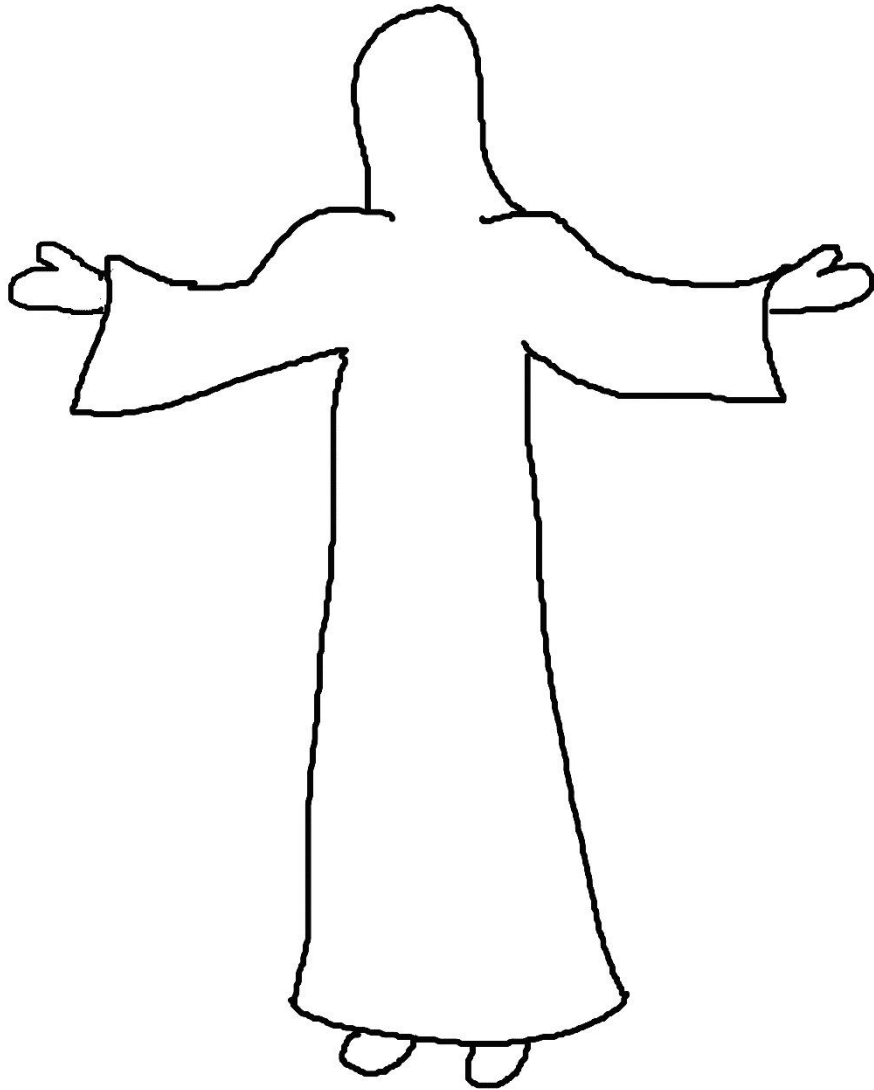
You are invited to share your artistic creations as a part of worship for Transfiguration Sunday, February 14. You are welcome to share your own art or complete a coloring page from this packet.

Mark 9:2-9

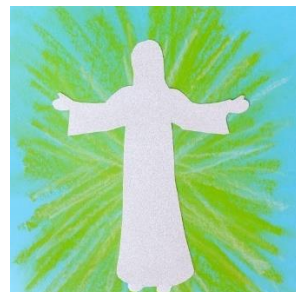

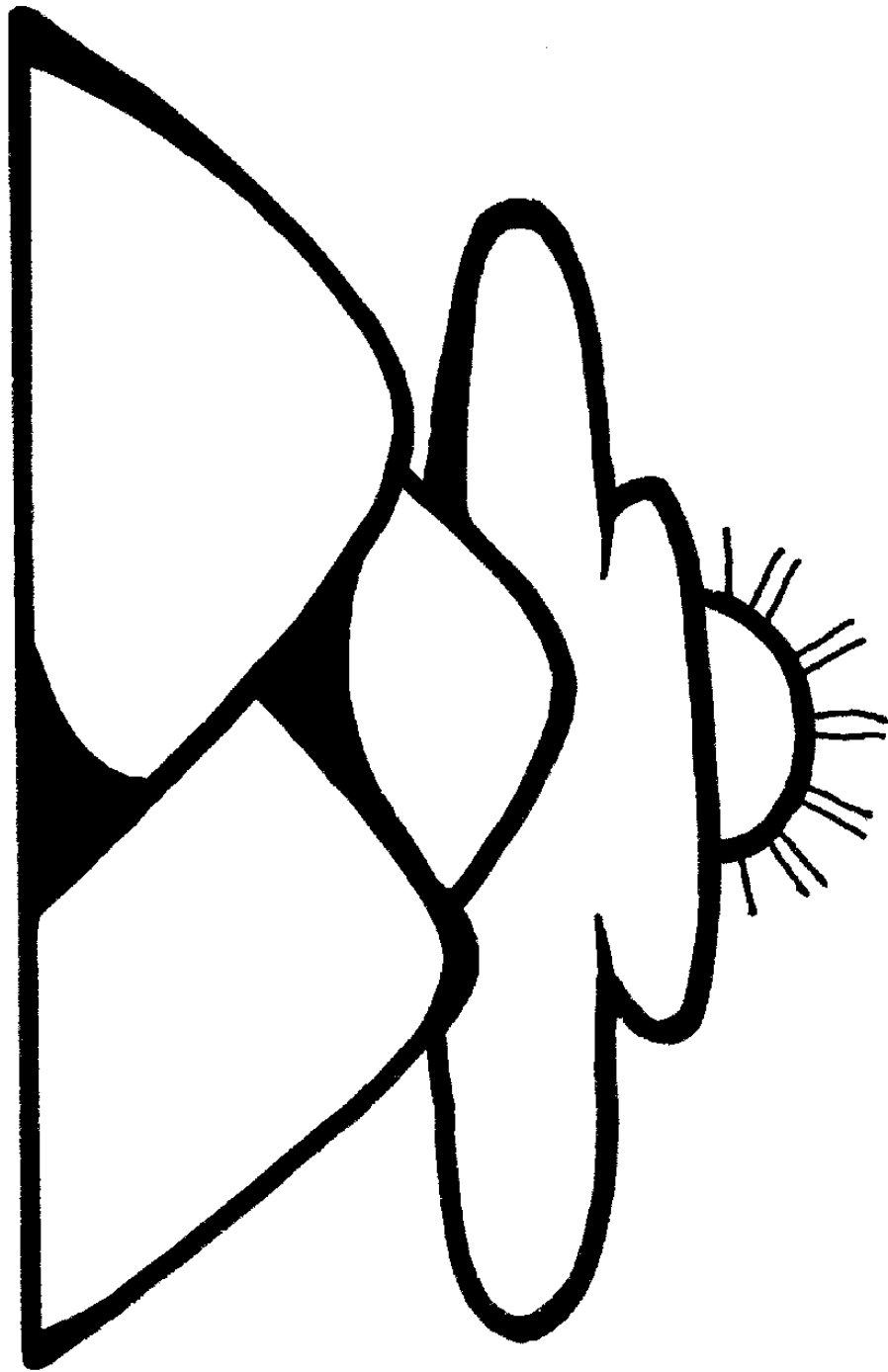
